

AISLE SIGNS

Warehouse aisle signs are used to identify rack and floor storage aisles by displaying numbering and/or character sequences, which help operatives find pallet locations easily. They are generally attached to or hung at the end face of racking, shelving, and storage lanes.

Aisle markers are typically manufactured from 1/8" PVC with content applied direct to the board with full color range.

Common rack sign sizes are 12" x 12" for a single character sign, or 12" x 16-18" for double character signs, while shelf markers are generally smaller, 8" x 8" for a single character or 8" x 12" for double character signs. Storage lane signs are often 48" x 48" and over.

The signs can be installed using most hardware options, and often with double sided adhesive pads, self-drilling screws, magnetic holders, as well as cable or chain for hanging.

Signs can also be manufactured in materials to withstand considerable temperature fluctuations, making them ideal for national standardization.
